	When possible, residents and staff will shelter in place, meaning residents will not be evacuated to another location. Our ability to shelter in place depends on many variables such as the integrity of the physical structure, access to food, water and medical supplies and the ability to maintain safe indoor temperatures.						
	Some types of emergencies, disasters or incidents may require evacuation of our facility. Near the time of the evacuation, staff will make attempts to notify you of the evacuation location and if known, the expected length of evacuation. When possible, residents may opt to go home with their representative, family or friends. We will maintain information on where all residents were evacuated to.
